We are delighted to report we had over **350 hike participants, 21 teams**, including a **motorcycle team of 12** to lead the hike, **1,200 individual donors, 75 volunteers** and thanks to all of you and our **25 sponsors** we have reached our fund-raising goal of an outstanding **\$100,000!**

Our **25 silent auction** items collectively raised **\$4,000** for the Hospice and many items sold for more than twice their market value! Your contributions were so appreciated and helpful. We are grateful to our volunteer bakers who contributed over **60 dozen cookies**. **The Red Apron**, locally owned and operated, contributed **400 delicious sandwiches** and served hikers with a smile on hike day.

Our very own **Hospice Board** who formed Team Board Walk was the second highest fundraising team in all of Canada, raising over **\$15,000**.

Ali Black, Coordinator of Volunteers at the Hospice raised over **\$11,000** from over 100 individual supporters and is the second highest individual fundraiser in all of Canada. **Ali ranked #1 as the individual hiker with the highest number of individual supporters in all of Canada!** Thank you to all our wonderful volunteers who supported Ali!
